Wireless Internet Access Policy

The Terryville Public Library offers free wireless Internet access to patrons with wireless-enabled laptop computers or handheld devices. By accessing the service, the patron has agreed to abide by the library's Internet Computer Use Policy.

Library staff cannot provide the wireless card, configure or troubleshoot your equipment. Staff will verify that the wireless connection is functioning.

- Wireless access is available in the public areas of the library.
- If audio files are accessed, the use of patron supplied headphones is required.
- Printing is not available.

The wireless network is not secure. It is the patron's responsibility to protect their wireless equipment through the use of the latest anti-virus protection, spyware, and other standard security measures. It is highly recommended that file sharing be turned off, and that credit card information, passwords or other sensitive personal information not be transmitted while using the wireless network.

The library assumes no responsibility for damage caused to your laptop or handheld device from configuration changes, power surges, viruses or software downloaded while accessing the wireless network.

Equipment should never be left unattended in the library. The library assumes no responsibility for physical damage, loss or theft of equipment or files.
