



Mobile WiFi Hotspot

Quick Start Instructions

A Mobile WiFi Hotspot allows you to wirelessly connect your mobile device/laptop/computer to the internet.

- 1.) **Make sure the hotspot is fully charged.** Plug the USB-C power adapter that came with your Hotspot into the charging port, as shown here, then plug the A/C adapter into an electrical outlet.

The Battery indicator will glow, indicating approximate battery life remaining.

- 3 LEDs light up blue: Battery level 80% - 100%
- 2 LEDs light up blue: Battery level 40% - 79%
- 1 LED lights up blue: Battery level 15% - 39%
- 1 LED lights up red: Battery level 1% - 14%

LEDs will flash while charging. Once the battery level is at 100%, 3 LEDs will display solid blue.

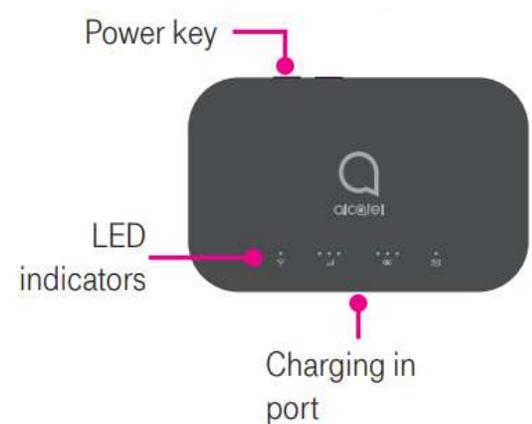
After charging, unplug the AC adapter from the outlet and unplug the adapter from the hotspot. Return the AC adapter to the hotspot kit.

- 2.) **Turn on the hotspot.** Press and hold the Power key for 3 seconds. It will activate automatically, but it may take a few minutes for the hotspot to connect to the T-Mobile cellular network. The Signal indicator will show your connection and signal strength.

- Good coverage: 3 LEDs all light up
- Middle coverage: 2 LEDs light up
